SIGS SURPRISE FANS AT 1962 FOOTBALL GAME



The "Original RF" was designed for the Fresno State vs San Jose State football game in 1962. It was known that many Fresno Sigma Chis were going to attend. The idea for the card trick prank (RF) was **Jim Green's** (58-S). Jim got brother **Glenn Davis** (59-F), an engineering major, to plot out on graph paper to scale the card trick section at the stadium. Head cheerleader **Gary Johnson** (59-F), cheerleader **John Wellfare** (60-F) and the other cheerleaders knew nothing about what was to take place.

The cheerleaders earlier in the day put the colored/numbered cards under each seat in the card trick section. At specific times during the game brother Johnson would call out a number which would prompt each person sitting in the card trick section to hold up a specific-colored card the combination of which would spell a word or words.

Before the game future Significant Sig **Jim Green**, future Consul **Ron LaRocca** (61-F), **Bob Rich** (61-

F) and future Consul **Tom Oliver** (61-F) snuck into the stadium and changed all the numbers on the cards. When brother Johnson called out a number, instead of what he thought would come up, "Sigs", "Hello Sigma Chi Alumni" and a few other Sigrelated words came up. Photos were taken of the Sig card tricks and were pictured in future Sigma Chi rush booklets.
