

FAMILY OF FRESNO SIG DONATES \$97,000 TO FRESNO STATE

Fresno State business students seeking scholarships will have a bit more support coming their way with a \$97,000 donation from the Pressutti family. The Pressutti Scholarship was established in 2011 in memory of Joseph E. Pressutti [64-F], an lowa native who moved to Hanford in 1962. The Craig School graduate had a varied career as a certified public accountant, venturing into a "nearly 40-year storm of acquisitions and mergers, start-ups and rescues," according to his 2008 obituary."

Joe entered Fresno State as a chemistry major, but soon changed to accounting. After graduation he was hired by Price-Waterhouse, the largest accounting firm in the US. Joe worked in Southern California and had several celebrity clients including Jack Warner of Warner

Brothers Studios. He got involved in the roofing industry and held several patents. He created a company to manufacturer one invention, a ridge shingle, in Fresno. Joe was an amazing person who was pre-ordained to be an entrepreneur.

MESSAGE FROM THE MIDDLE EAST

Sending my very best to the brothers of Sigma Chi. I belong to the 40th Infantry Division as Chief of Staff. We return from our CENTCOM/ARCENT deployment to the Levant area on or about beginning of April 2024. We should be home just in time to file taxes.

Since October 7, our Area of Operations have seen significant threat activities. I was originally deployed to Jordan as Officer in Charge for the DIV. I am now living in Kuwait and working the usual 100-hour week. Days go by extremely quickly and I will reunite with Katie soon in Los Osos.

The 40ID has control and authority over 4,600 services members from across all three compositions of the army (AD, NG, & AR) spread across KSA, UAE, Qatar, Kuwait, Jordan, and other locations. Unfortunately, an attack occurred in

Jordan which caused the death of 3x services members from the 411th Engineers (Army Reserve) located in Georgia. The remains were transported and received by families where our escorts provided some comfort to families during the worst moments in life.

Despite these events, we continue our current mission set and prepare for other on-coming attacks. At the same time, we prepare for redeployment home and integration of our replacements next month. Our daughter lives in Fresno and during a future visit I will coordinate with a Sigma Chi event and attend.


