1460 E BULLDOG LANE FOUR-STORY HOUSING PROJECT

A local family submitted plans to the City of Fresno in 2023 to construct a 4-story housing project on the lot east of the Chapter House. We learned of this project earlier this year.

A call for help was issued and Brothers McGuinness, Robinson and Scott sprang into action. Fresno State parties were also engaged and have been holding bi-weekly meetings with the Greek Housing representatives on Fraternity & Sorority Malls. Brady, Bill, and Mark provide detailed updates at each session.

Call to Action. Connected with your Fresno City Council Representative, Mayor or others to share our concerns. We support student housing if it is compatible with the neighborhood.

Suggested statement to use in conversations (customize to make it your own):

"I would like to discuss a proposed 4 story 33-unit apartment building being processed by the Planning Department for a vacant .78-acre lot at 1460 East Bulldog Lane which is part of a 12-lot unique neighborhood subdivision of 2 story fraternity and sorority houses developed by Fresno State in the 1960s."

"The subdivision has CC&Rs that restrict height, ground floor minimum square footage, parking, setbacks, etc., which have not been incorporated into the project design. The developer has not engaged the other property owners in the subdivision about the design. Fresno State is holding meetings with the property owners to determine what course action can be taken. The Planning Director and City Attorney's office have been notified of the surrounding property owner's concerns via a letter from legal counsel."

BROTHER PHILLIP SANCHEZ TO BE CONSIDERED BY CUSD FOR NAME OF SCHOOL

Order of Constantine, Significant Sig and Ambassador **Phillip V Sanchez** (52-T) is one of the names being considered for a new Clovis Unified School District school. The new intermediate school

is planned at the Bradley Educational Center next to future Clovis South High School at Leonard and McKinley Avenue is Fresno.

The CUSD Governing Board is to act on the new school naming at its April or May session. If you are in contact with a board member, reach out to them and share your support of the naming in honor of Chapter Eternal Brother Sanchez.


