Treasurer's Report

We want to thank all Brothers who support of the Alumni Chapter through your annual \$50 dues payments. A special thank you to those who add an additional donation. For those who have used the online dues portal, you likely received a reminder recently that our new Alumni Chapter dues year (our fiscal year) begins July 1, 2024. A good number of you have already responded by making an online \$50 payment.

About 75% of the dues paying brothers pay during this time period. The rest of you pay throughout the year, and that is perfectly fine! On the monthly "Dues & Donations" chart in the newsletter, we list all those who have paid during the preceding 12 months. Dues can be paid online through the Alumni Chapter website (fresnosigsalumni.org) or by mail (P.O. Box 7803, Fresno, CA 93727).

As always, our policy is that dues are voluntary. We appreciate them, but we welcome any Brother at any time with or without. One might say, "You will always find it here!"

The dues support our regular alumni chapter activity. We use them for such things as Active Chapter support, Derby Day fundraising ads, 50-year member pins, graduation stoles for graduating seniors, alumni dinner costs for speakers and active brothers in attendance, our alumni chapter mini-storage rental, an annual national fraternity affiliation fee, website and dues portal costs, etc.

As of May 31, the Alumni Chapter checking and money market accounts have a total balance of \$26,593.93. This is inflated by \$11,450 which is being held for the Philip V. Sanchez Memorial Bridge signage. Our Fresno Sigma Chi Foundation and White Rose Scholarship funds are much more substantial, but they are held separately and administered by a separate board and treasurer.

Our Fresno State Sigma Chi Active Chapter is the best on campus due to the quality and character of the active members. Our Alumni Chapter is one of the best in the nation because of your participation (and the outstanding leadership of Brad Fischer). Thank you for your support and brotherhood.



As a headline announcement, The Magazine of Sigma Chi publicized its *Monuments and Memorials Commission* voted the *John Wayne Birthplace Home and Museum* to be a Memorial Monument on the Sigma Chi trail of history.

April 14, 2022 our Southwest Florida alumni chapters submitted application for the Birthplace Museum to be a Sigma Chi Memorial Monument. In less than ninety days we received unanimous approval.

We then launched an Alumni Chapter Project for Sigma Chi to own *in-perpetuity naming rights* at the Museum. Presently, there is *absolutely nothing* about Duke being a member of Sigma Chi at this well patronized Museum. The archives of photos and memorabilia are solely dedicated to the life and legend of John Wayne - *an authentic*

American Icon.

The response by the Brotherhood has been gratifying. A significant number of Golden State alumni have joined the Campaign. We were also inspired to launch this journey because of Duke's everlasting loyalty to Sigma Chi.

As John Wayne generously gave of his time and treasure to Sigma Chi, we kindly ask you to please invite your members to join us and donate to the Campaign. Together, we will make a difference for time immemorial for the Good of Sigma Chi.
