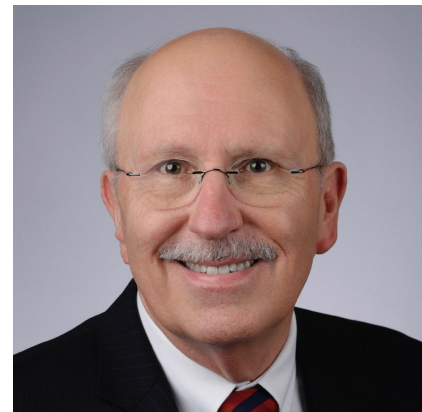

BROTHER RODGER JENSEN SIGNIFICANT SIG CLASS OF 2025

Rodger B Jensen (52-T), is the pioneer of pistachio production in the Central Valley of California, a philanthropist and supporter of higher education. Brother Jensen joined the Sigma Chi Fraternity on February 23, 1952. Alumni members of Sigma Tau Fraternity were accepted by the Sigma Chi Fraternity on this date of the charter of the Epsilon Eta Chapter. The Sigma Tau Fraternity was founded on November 10, 1921 at Fresno State. Rodger joined that fraternity in 1939 and served as its Premier (president) in 1941.

Rodger was born in Parlier. He graduated from

Fresno State in 1941. Rodger's agricultural roots run deep in the Central Valley and has a long history of philanthropy and support to higher education.

A decorated Air Force veteran who served from 1941-1946, 1st Lt. Rodger Jensen was a B-29 pilot during World War II. His aircraft "Horrible Monster" completed the final combat mission of the war, a bombing run on an oil refinery in northern Japan.

After the war, Rodger returned to Fresno, where he purchased low-value dryland farm ground. In 1950 he established S & J Ranch, a farm management company. During his presidency, S & J was one of the largest tree crop farmers in California, largest olive producer and the largest independent almond and pistachio processor.

At 104 he continues to farm citrus under his company name, Jenco Farms. He also actively manages his other business venture San Pablo Properties.

Because of his devoted service to California agriculture and unwavering commitment to his community, Mr. Jensen was honored in 1999 by Fresno State's Ag One as the seventh Community Salute honoree.

The California Pistachio Research Board pledged \$1.5 million to establish a faculty position at Fresno State, named the Rodger B. Jensen Endowed Professorship in Pistachio Physiology and Pomology in his honor.

In 1998 Rodger and his wife Margaret donated 167 acres in hopes of helping to preserve the San Joaquin River bottom. The Jensen Ranch was donated to the San Joaquin River Parkway Trust to

restore and connect the area between the regional Woodward Park and the river. Margaret & Rodger Jensen are recognized as Major Donors who have lifetime contributions of over \$150,000 to the San Joaquin River Parkway Trust.

Rodger has served on the Fresno State Board of Governors and on boards of the Fresno Historical Society, California and Fresno Chambers of Commerce, North Fresno Rotary and Children's Hospital of Central California. With a major gift he established The Rodger and Margaret Jensen Family Chapel at Valley Children's Hospital.

In 1990 Rodger received the Arthur Safstrom Service Award as part of the annual Fresno State Top Dog Alumni Awards. In recognition of their devoted service to California agriculture and to bettering their community, the Board of Trustees of the California State University and California State University Fresno conferred on Rodger B. Jensen and Margaret Jensen the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters in 2009.

He has been an active member of our Sigma Chi Alumni Chapter of Fresno and supported our local scholarship endowment at the Fresno State Alumni Association. Rodger has actively served as a fraternal member of over 85 years in his lifetime.

BRAD FISCHER NAMED ORDER OF CONSTANTINE

On February 12, 2025, Sigma Chi International recognized brother **Brad Fischer** (78-S) as an Order of Constantine Sig. Brad will be inducted at the 85th Grand Chapter of Sigma Chi which will be held June 26–29, 2025, at the Gaylord Rockies Resort and Convention Center in Aurora, Colorado.

“Each year, the Order of Constantine recognizes a

group of Sigma Chi brothers for their commitment, dedication, and service to the Fraternity. Induction into the Order of Constantine is the highest honor that the Sigma Chi Fraternity bestows upon one of its members.

The honor of being named an Order of Constantine Sig has been conferred on just 829 brothers since the Order's inception at the 47th Grand Chapter in 1948.”

Because of the limits placed on annual inductions, on average a chapter would be able to induct one brother every 21 years while Epsilon Eta averages one every 5 years. Currently only 21 brothers can be inducted into the Order of Constantine each year. Epsilon Eta now has a total of 15 with 8 still living.

Through the many years Brad’s leadership, mentoring and attention to detail the Fresno Sigma Chi Alumni Chapter has become the only fraternity alumni organization on the Fresno State campus that has enough critical mass to create significant activities for its alumni and to strongly support an undergraduate chapter. Epsilon Eta has the finest fraternity house on the Fresno State campus, it is maintained in pristine condition and has no debt.

EPSILON ETA JOINS SIGMA CHI BELL CHAPTER

The Epsilon Eta chapter has just qualified for the prestigious Bell Endowed Chapter Fund this month thanks to several Epsilon Eta alumni as reported by Mike Patton (63-S). So far, they have committed

\$625,000 with 1/2 going to EH scholarships and 1/2 going to on-site transformational leadership training for the Active Chapter brothers.

We need just one or two more brothers for the final \$125,000 payable over multiple years to get us to the critically important on-site training level.

While the additional scholarships supplement our scholarship program, the leadership training is a game changer for our undergraduate brothers. From brother Jeff Burnside, Beta Upsilon 1980, "Epsilon Eta will get former Grand Consul, Mike Greenberg, Alpha Iota 1982, to run the inaugural training. He may have one or two other trainers with him. There are several categories of leadership you can select.

Generally speaking, the \$750,000 endowment gets the "Leadership Journey" described as a mini-Horizons for the entire chapter."

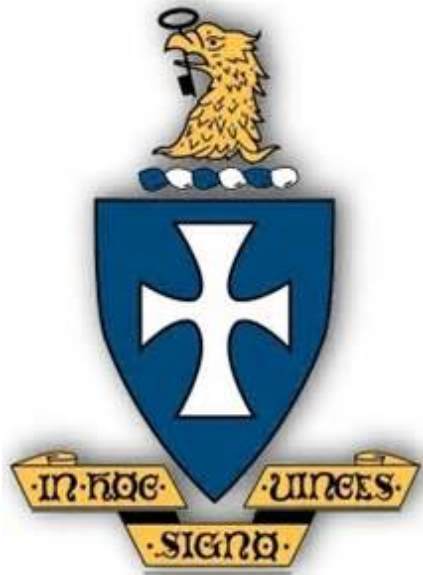
