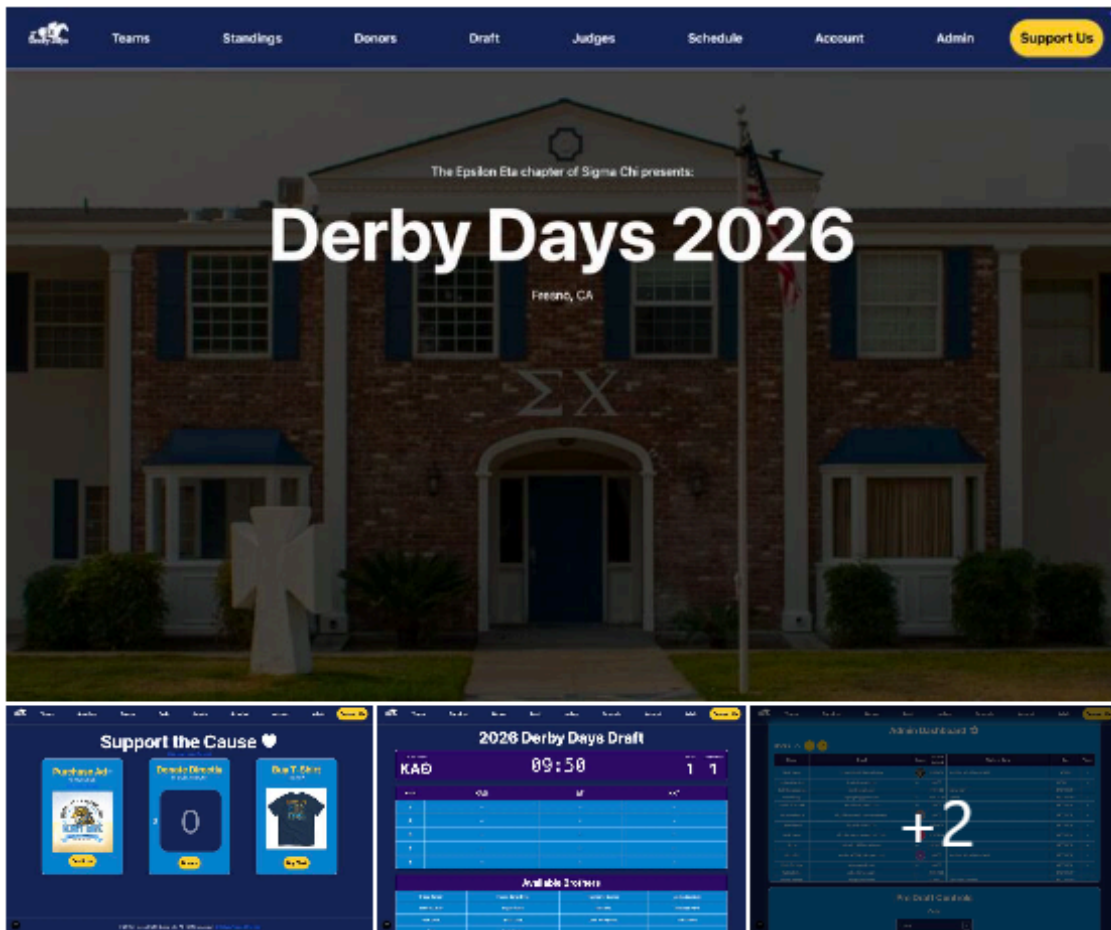
**DERBY DAYS 2006 NEW WEBSITE –

For the past 60 years, my fraternity, Sigma Chi at Fresno State, has hosted an annual, month long philanthropy called Derby Days to support Valley Children's Hospital. It brings together multiple sororities in a competitive, high-energy effort to raise money for a cause that matters deeply to our community.

As Derby Days grew, the systems behind it didn't. The event relied on spreadsheets, manual updates, and disconnected tools to manage donations, teams, ad sales, and logistics which made it increasingly difficult to scale and keep participants engaged in real time.

That experience led me to build derbydays.org, a centralized web app I've been developing over the past 7 months to run the entire philanthropy in one place. The platform supports donation tracking, ad and t-shirt sales, live standings, team and user management, and even a live fantasy sports-style draft for one of the events.

CHANGE IN THE 2026 WINE TASTING EARNINGS

Epsilon Eta's Chapter House requires emergency repairs relating to water leaks and the resulting water damage including dry rot. Plus, the front sliding glass door needs replacement because it is warped and cannot latch or lock. The corrections are necessary to prevent even more expensive damage and to allow the securing of the House.

The exact cost of this work cannot be estimated until certain parts of the House are opened for inspection, but the cost will be substantial. The House was first occupied during the spring 1967 semester making it 59 years old, so maintenance will always be a challenge.

The Chapter House is our most important icon. To help pay for this work, the Wine Tasting Committee voted unanimously to dedicate this year's income from the silent auction to the House Corporation.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Thank you to all of you who support our brotherhood through payment of Alumni Chapter dues and generous support to our Housing Corporation and Fresno Sigma Chi Foundation. We exist as one of the very best Sigma Chi Alumni Chapters for a number of reasons – strong bonds of friendship, best Alumni Chapter President, active and caring brothers, etc. But we also excel because of the financial support our membership provides on a fully voluntary basis. The funds we receive allow us to maintain the chapter house, to provide scholarships for active brothers, to give modest support toward their activities (rush, graduation, Derby Week ads), to store our Chapter archives, to maintain our national alumni chapter membership, to pay for our online portal, to host 5 active brothers at each Alumni meeting, and to even buy a few raffle prizes for those who come to the monthly meetings (we're talking key chains, baggage tags and an occasional bottle of wine). Sigma Chi and our alumni members continue to maintain a prominent presence in the Fresno State community. Your support both financially and otherwise makes this possible, so please take a bow!

I serve as Alumni Chapter Treasurer – mostly that means I collect dues. The Housing Corp. and Foundation have separate books and hard-working governance boards. I am reporting here only on the financial status of the Alumni Chapter.

As of December 31, 2025, we maintain two bank accounts – a checking account and a very low-risk money market account. The total balance of the two accounts is \$18,337.93.

Because most dues are paid in the July - August timeframe, our balance will gradually decline until next July. Our revenues come almost exclusively from dues and occasional donations from individual Brothers. While it is not much, our bank balance provides some rainy day funds in case of such future need.

We prepare the monthly Dues & Donations chart in the newsletter to acknowledge those Brothers who pay the voluntary dues or contribute to the Housing Corp. or Foundation. I apologize that I occasionally miss a name. PLEASE point it out to me if your name is ever omitted.

The chart this month shows all names of Brothers who have paid dues or donations in the last 12 months. If your name is not on the chart, it is because I do not have record of a payment (either by check or the online portal) at some time in 2025 or 2026.

If you have not attended an Alumni Chapter meeting lately, please add it to your calendar. Meetings are low-key and all attendees are warmly welcomed. We usually have fascinating speakers, mostly from Fresno State faculty or staff. You can also meet a handful of our very impressive Active Chapter

Brothers. Come with an oldpledge brother or come alone. When it comes to brotherhood, you will always find it here!

Items can include, photographs, invitations, programs, clothing, jewelry, award certificates, trophy's, scrapbooks, etc.

Keep materials in a dry and temperature-controlled environment

Avoid folding any materials

Write the names of people featured in photographs on the back using a #2 pencil

Write an explanation of people, events, places, etc. to accompany your items

Place like materials in a box, folder, envelope or Ziplock

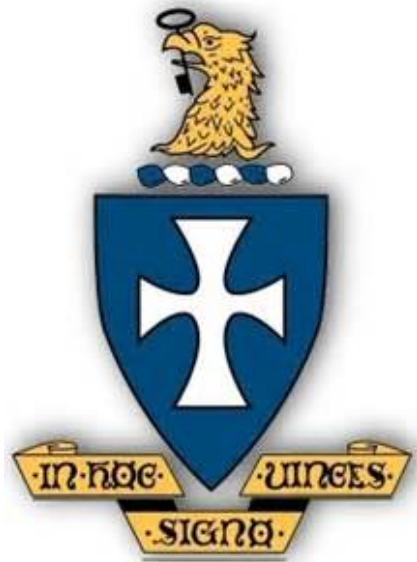
